Girls on the Run (GOTR) Presentation by Doreen Dunne, Council Director for Girls on the Run of Long Island:

GOTR is a national non-profit which offers after school programs with a curriculum focused on helping girls in grades 3-8 be joyful, healthful and confident.

There is currently an after-school program at Jackson. There are 28 teams on Long Island serving about 350 girls.

Each lesson has a theme and running is woven into each lesson. At the end of the season, girls run a 5K. This year's run is taking place December 4th at Eisenhower Park.

Each season is 16 lessons and all take place outdoors. Programs are split into grades 3-5 and grades 6-8.

To start an afterschool program, we would need 2 volunteers per team of 6-15 girls. Coaches do not need to be runners, but they must be willing to volunteer 2x per week for 75 minutes each time. Volunteers would be trained by GOTR.

The spring season will start around March 20 and end at the beginning of June.
